FAR AWAY BIRDING TOURS - always include *Michael Carmody* as 1st or 2nd guide (based destination and his familiarity with the birds). Michael manages the pace, activities, and the birding to maximize the tour experience, birding success, and enjoyment of the country. The country is explored with birds as a major focus.

HERITAGE-STYLE BIRDING TOURS - are offered in countries with a 'manageable' number of key birds, allowing for ***both birding and touring*** - the only honest option when a spouse, partner, or friend do not share the passion. ***Birding is the major focus*** however the daily program incorporates a variety of activities, historical and cultural interactions, more in-depth studies in natural history, and added daily breaks to relax and unwind. Within Mexico only the '**Yucatan Tour**' affords both the infrastructure and a 'manageable' bird-list to support successful Heritage-Style birding.
