## WILD, UNTAMED COUNTRYSIDE - LIMITLESS CANYONS & PLAINS JUNE 3<sup>rd</sup>- 19<sup>TH</sup>, 2023 [Open Birding Tour]

NORTHERN MEXICO'S SUMMER ENDEMICS

This 'Must-Do' route targets a swath of Mexico's birds known more from myth than from birder's life-lists (half a dozen have been recorded by no other birding company); Thicket Tinamou, Montezuma Quail, Thick-billed and Maroon-fronted parrots, Yellow-headed and Red-crowned amazons, Eared Quetzal, Flammulated Owl, Tamaulipas Pygmy-Owl, Tawny-collared Nightjar, Gray-collared Becard, Colima Warbler, Altamira Yellowthroat, Crimson-collared Grosbeak, and Worthen's Sparrow. Route includes a morning mini-pelagic in the Sea of Cortez for Craveri's Murrelet. Begins in Monterrey, Nuevo Leon and ends in Hermosillo, Sonora. # Style and Structure of Tour Planning: 2023 - 2025

[1] **<u>OPEN BIRDING TOURS</u>** - are offered primarily in Mexico, our '*patch*' for the past thirty years. Participation is **open** to anyone on a first-come-first-serve basis. Tours in this style repeat a daily pattern of searching-out key target species, and are best characterized to others as a <u>'birding as the primary-focus'</u> experience.

[2] **HERITAGE-STYLE BIRDING TOURS\*** - are conducted in countries with a 'manageable' bird-list, a variety of equally interesting experiences, and a comfortable infrastructure, especially accommodations. Within Mexico only the **'Yucatan Tour'** affords both the infrastructure and a 'manageable' bird-list to support a successful birding tour using the Heritage-Style format.

[2] **FAR AWAY BIRDING TOURS\*** - offered in countries with a '*targetable*' birdlist, with local guides hired for language service, birding activities, and meals. These countries offer a comfortable infrastructure, especially accommodations, and *Michael always accompanies these tours, serving as the second guide*.

[4] <u>**CUSTOM TOURS</u>** - Annually around one-in-four of our departures are with small groups, couples, and individuals that have contacted Legacy Tours directly with a list of target birds, a destination idea, or a special need/desire. *These trips require commitment and planning well in advance to lock-in optimum dates*.</u>
